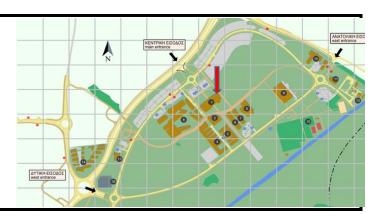

2. Reaching Nicosia



There are two international airports in Cyprus: 1) Larnaca airport (code LCA) and 2) Pafos airport (code PFO). Most major airlines use the Larnaca airport (which is also closer to Nicosia, around 45 mins). Note: It is STRONGLY discouraged to fly to Ercan airport. It is situated at the **Turkish occupied area and is therefore, illegal and** not recognized by any international body (mainly Turkish airlines use the specific airport). Since it is not a legal airport, it cannot be assumed that its Air Traffic Control follows all the strict safety regulations that are imposed by IATA or Eurocontrol).

Upon arrival at Larnaca airport, there are two ways you can get to Nicosia:

Taxi

Taxis are located right outside the airport. Drivers usually charge €50.00- €55.00 for the ride. Please note the prices for taxis vary depending on the time of arrival. If your flight arrives late, this is really your only option.

Larnaca bus stop: Larnaca International Airport.

Nicosia bus stop: Kyrenias Avenue, behind Melconian. Opposite Police Headquarters

At the Arrival Area, after the customs on the left hand side towards the bus exit.

This service costs €8 per person; however, it will not take you directly to your hotel. From the last stop, you would need to get a taxi or walk to the hotel of residence (please check distances on google maps).

3. Hotel Recommendations and How to Reach the University of Cyprus

A bus will be booked by the UCY to transport the participants from/to the University of Cyprus (**New Campus; 1 Panepistimiou Avenue**). The bus will collect the participants from Plateia Solomou (Solomos square, Nicosia city centre, [Link to Google Maps]) at **8.30 am** (**12.30 pm on Tuesday** 23/10/18) and will return at the same location after the end of the daily activities. A number of hotels can be found near Plateia Solomou.

For those who like to stay around the venue **Hassare B&B** is the excellent choice for you since it is located only 2km away from University of Cyprus. The **rate for a single room in B&B basis is 80€ per day.**

For those who would like to stay in the city centre there are 3 recommended budget hotels:

1. Asty Hotel

Asty Hotel which is located in the residential area of Agios Dometios (adjacent to Engomi) offers comfortable budget accommodation in Nicosia.

Single Room: 50€ per day in B&B basis

2. Semeli Hotel

Semeli Hotel is located in the financial and business centre of Nicosia and offers a great base for exploring Cyprus' capital.

Single Room: 100€ per day in B&B basis

3. Centrum Hotel

Excellently located in the centre of **Nicosia**, just steps away from the upgraded areas of Ledra and Onasagorou Street, where **restaurants**, cafes, and museums can be found.

Single Room: 90€ per day in B&B basis

4. Food and Catering

UCY will arrange to have hot and cold beverages for the morning and afternoon breaks. Lunch break will be a warm buffet. Please inform Mrs. Constantina Ioannou (ioannou.constantina@ucy.ac.cy) for any dietary restrictions.

5. WIFI

WIFI will be provided by the conference facility. Further details will be given in the meeting room.
