How to get to Eindhoven:

Eindhoven is easily accessible from Schiphol International Airport and Eindhoven Airport and is well connected to the railway network. The University is on walking distance from the railway station.

From Schiphol International Airport

Train:

Eindhoven is well connected to the national railroad system. There are direct trains departing every 30 minutes at xx.16 and xx.46. It will take you about 1.30 hour to get to

Eindhoven Central Station. You can buy the train tickets directly at the airport NS Information Desk or ticket machine by card. More information on www.ns.nl/en

Schiphol railway station is situated at the airport.

From Eindhoven Airport to central railway station Eindhoven/University of Technology (TUE)

Our University is easily accessible from Eindhoven Airport both by car as by public transport.

By bus

The cheapest way to get to the city center is to get on the bus that stops at the airport parking area.

Line no. 400 is a direct service to Eindhoven Central Station.

Line no. 401 stops several times on the way to Central station.

In order to use the bus you can buy a rechargeable "OV-chipkaart" or buy a ticket in the bus with your bankcard.

If you would like to get to Eindhoven by taxi, reliable and reasonably priced companies are Cibatax (0800 2443333), Connexion Taxi Services (088 3394748) and Jansen Taxi (040 2838383).

The University is on walking distance from the railway station.

By car

You can enter the address: De Zaale, Eindhoven in your navigation system. You obtain a ticket at the barrier. TU/e uses a paid parking system in order to push back car use.
